PARTIAL AWARD  
ON AGREED TERMS

On 21 October 1983 THE STANWICK CORPORATION and STANWICK INTERNATIONAL INC., the Claimants in Case No. 66 ("STANWICK"), and THE MINISTRY OF NATIONAL DEFENCE OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN and THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC IRANIAN AIR FORCE, two of the Respondents herein, filed with the Tribunal a Memorandum of Understanding dated 19 October 1983 stated to be in "complete full and final settlement of all the claims and counterclaims between Stanwick, the Ministry of Defence of the Islamic Republic of Iran and its Air Force asserted by the parties in section VI B of the Statement of Claim in the Case no. 66", but stating that the settlement "shall have no effect with respect to claims against other parties in Case No. 66".

On 28 October 1983 the Agent of the Islamic Republic of Iran filed a letter informing the Tribunal that the Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran had agreed to the Settlement Agreement.

The Memorandum of Understanding provides for certain reciprocal obligations by the Parties.

Article III of the Memorandum of Understanding provides that payment shall be made from the Security Account established pursuant to paragraph 7 of the Declaration of the Government of the Democratic and Popular Republic of Algeria dated 19 January 1981. Article III provides, inter alia,

"The payments from the security account shall be made as follows:

1. \$100,000 shall be paid to Stanwick immediately upon filing a joint request for an Arbitral Award on agreed terms with this M.O.U. with the Tribunal.
2. \$400,000 shall be paid to Stanwick upon the presentation of the receipt attached hereto as Annex B to Chamber 1 of the Tribunal."

The Memorandum of Understanding is hereby recorded as a Partial Award on agreed terms, binding on the Parties. Consequently the Respondents THE MINISTRY OF NATIONAL DEFENCE OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN and THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC IRANIAN AIR FORCE are obligated to pay the Claimants THE STANWICK CORPORATION and STANWICK INTERNATIONAL INC. jointly a maximum of Five Hundred Thousand United States Dollars (\$500,000) in two payments to be made as follows:

Payment No. 1

The amount of \$100,000 described in Article III(1) of the Memorandum of Understanding;


Payment No. 2

An amount not exceeding \$400,000 described in Article III (2) of the Memorandum of Understanding, the exact amount to be the figure specified in the Receipt in the form attached to the Memorandum of Understanding as Annex B, to be paid as soon as practicable after the filing with the Tribunal of such Receipt.

The said obligations shall be satisfied by payment out of the Security Account established pursuant to paragraph 7 of the Declaration of the Government of the Democratic and Popular Republic of Algeria dated 19 January 1981.


This Award is hereby submitted to the President of the Tribunal for notification to the Escrow Agent of the payment described as "Payment No. 1" above. The Tribunal will make a separate submission to the President for the purpose of notification for Payment No. 2 after the Tribunal has satisfied itself that the requisite requirements with respect to this payment have been met.

I agree with the Chairman in accepting and recording of the Settlement Agreement as an Award on agreed terms but I dissent as to the remaining part of this Award not only because that part unilaterally condemns one of the parties to the performance of its obligations and ignores the reciprocal obligations of the other party but also because it provides for an enforcement procedure, which a judge is barred from after deciding the dispute or accepting and recording the settlement, according to Article 34 of the UNCITRAL Rules.

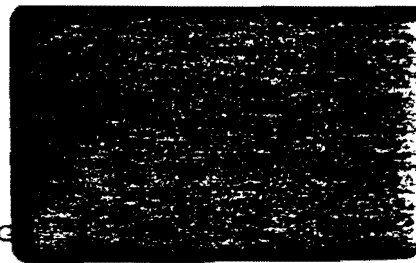
Concurring. The Joint Request for an Arbitral Award on Agreed Terms and the Memorandum of Understanding appear to be signed by only one Respondent, the Iranian Air Force. The letter filed by the Agent of the Government of Iran on 28 October 1983 is only relevant to the extent it constitutes agreement to the Joint Request and the Memorandum of Understanding by another party in the case (The Islamic Republic of Iran). My views with regard to the comments set forth above Dr. Kashani's signature are explained in my Concurring Opinions in Case Nos. 279, 427 and 807 (Part IV).

JOINT REQUEST FOR ARBITRAL AWARD  
 ( PARTIAL ) ON AGREED TERMS

Pursuant to article 34 of the provisional rules of the Iran-U.S. Claims Tribunal, claimants The Stanwick Corporation and Stanwick International Inc. (Stanwick) and respondent Ministry of National Defense of the Islamic Republic of Iran (Ministry) jointly request the Tribunal to issue an Arbitral Award (partial) on agreed terms that will record and give effect to the Settlement Agreement in the Memorandum of Understanding (M.O.U.) between the parties hereto, which Settlement Agreement (M.O.U.) is annexed hereto as Exhibit A.


The Settlement Agreement (M.O.U.) dated October 19, 1983 resolves all claims and counterclaims which have been asserted or are capable of being asserted in relation to Case no. 66 filed with the Iran-U.S. Claims Tribunal as they relate to the claims and counterclaims of the Ministry of Defense Islamic Republic Iranian Air Force, and requires, inter alia, payment by the respondent Ministry to claimant Stanwick of \$ 500,000 U.S. dollars from the security account.

Accordingly, the parties request the Tribunal to record the Settlement Agreement (M.O.U.) and enter an Arbitral Award (partial) on agreed terms in accordance with the provisions thereof.

This Settlement does not effect the claims of Stanwick against the Ministry of Defense Islamic Republic Iranian Navy, Bank Markazi, Bank Mellat and Bank Tejarat all of which are still outstanding in Case no. 66.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING between the Stanwick Corporation and the Ministry of Defense of the Islamic Republic of Iran and its Air Force

ARTICLE I - Parties

This Memorandum of Understanding (M.O.U.) is signed by and between the Ministry of Defense of the Islamic Republic of Iran (hereinafter "Ministry"), its Air Force (Respondent) and the Stanwick Corporation and Stanwick International Inc. (hereinafter "Stanwick") (Claimant).

Whereas, Stanwick has filed certain claims against the Ministry and its Air Force with the Iran-United States Claims Tribunal, The Hague, the Netherlands, set forth in section VI B of the Statement of Claims in Case no. 66 in relation to the contract no. 137,

Whereas, the Ministry and its Air Force have filed certain defences and counter claims pertaining to the said claims,

Whereas, Stanwick and the Ministry and its Air Force desire to resolve all claims and disputes between them,

Whereas, the parties have, with a view to settle their disputes, entered negotiations in London and later in The Hague.

Now therefore, in consideration of the mutual covenants, premises, and agreements herein set forth, the parties hereby agree as follows.

ARTICLE II - Purpose

The purpose of signing this M.O.U. is complete full and final settlement of all the claims and counterclaims between Stanwick, the Ministry of Defense of the Islamic Republic of Iran and its Air Force asserted by the parties in section VI B of the Statement of Claim in the Case no. 66 filed with the Iran-United States Claims Tribunal, Chamber 1. The parties shall submit this M.O.U. to the Iran-U.S. Claims Tribunal together with a joint request for an arbitral award on agreed terms as set forth herein. This M.O.U. shall only be effective between the parties hereto and shall have no effect with respect to claims against other parties in Case no. 66 before the tribunal.

ARTICLE III - Payment

The Ministry admits to being indebted to Stanwick in the sum of \$ 500,000 U.S. dollars, and agrees to pay that amount to Stanwick. Therefore, the Ministry agrees that the sum of \$ 500,000 U.S. dollars be paid to Stanwick out of the security account established for the satisfaction of the tribunal awards in accordance with paragraph 7 of the general declaration of the government of the Democratic and Popular Republic of Algeria, subject to the provisions set out in this M.O.U. Stanwick also agrees to accept the said amount (\$ 500,000 U.S. dollars) in full and final settlement of its claim as described in article II.



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The Ministry further agrees to release its call on letter of credit no. RNB 79007 in the amount of \$ 255,000 after delivery of the items on the List of Materials attached hereto as Annex A to its freight forwarder (Gener) in London.

The payments from the security account shall be made as follows:

1. \$ 100,000 shall be paid to Stanwick immediately upon filing a joint request for an Arbitral Award on agreed terms with this M.O.U. with the Tribunal.
2. \$ 400,000 shall be paid to Stanwick upon the presentation of the receipt attached hereto as Annex B to Chamber 1 of the Tribunal.

ARTICLE IV - Stanwick's obligations as prerequisite conditions for payment.

1. Upon the filing of the joint request with the Tribunal, Stanwick undertakes to deliver the items included in the attached list (henceforth called "Items in the attached list") which is signed by the parties and constitute an integral part of this M.O.U., to Gener (freight forwarder) in London. The said items have to be in as manufactured condition. Stanwick shall arrange for any inspection and certification of items to be in "as manufactured condition" by a qualified third party or company. Should the inspector determine that any item is not satisfactory for intended purpose Stanwick will reduce the amount agreed to in settlement by the cost of any such item as set forth in the attached list of items. The receipt attached hereto as Annex B will be submitted by Stanwick to Chamber 1, Iran-United States Claims Tribunal for an order of payment in accordance with the amount specified on said receipt.

2. Stanwick shall obtain from the government of the United States of America the export licence for the items in the attached list for destination of London.


3. Stanwick shall fully pay for transportation and insurance costs of the items on the attached list from the point of origin in the United States to the designated freight forwarder (Gener) in London in accordance with the provisions of contract 137.

ARTICLE V - Documents Required

The documents required for issuance of the Receipt as set forth in Annex B to Stanwick by the freight forwarder (Gener) is as follows:

1. A copy of the Bill of Lading indicating shipment of the items in the attached list to London.
2. A copy of the invoices indicating that Stanwick has paid the required insurance and sea freight costs for the transportation of the items on the attached list to London.

Upon receipt of the aforesaid documents the freight forwarder (Gener) shall execute and deliver to Stanwick the receipt attached hereto as Annex B.



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ARTICLE VI - Release of Claims

The parties hereto agree to release all their claims and counterclaims in Case no. 66 (article II) insofar as they relate to the Air Force.

ARTICLE VII - Stanwick shall defend and hold the Ministry harmless against any claims which have either been asserted or may be asserted by the third parties in relation to the items on the attached list.

In witness whereof, the parties have executed this Agreement as of the date set forth herein.






